This term the team alongside local church leaders have been busy delivering Leavers Lessons to Year 6 classes across the primary schools, to help them smoothly transition into secondary school.

This is an interactive lesson with a movie clip, wordsearch and quiz. Looking at the story of Joseph, we looked at the challenges he faced, and the fact that he rose to each one and trusted in God. We then talked about what challenges they feel they will face in secondary school and that there are many people who they can talk to about them. We also explained that PACE will be at their secondary school in both lessons and lunchtime clubs.

We are very grateful to the local churches for funding the 'It's Your Move' Scripture Union books that we are able to gift to 696 Year 6 students across Guernsey. This book contains wordsearches, quizzes, top tips and more. The students were delighted with their books.

NT MINI

In relation to the above event, the PACE team and current OT (Old Testament) Mini volunteers who teach the course in schools, met with Phil Baskerville in May to start training to become NT Mini presenters. It was wonderful to be with Phil again and spend a few days going through the signs (like sign language signs) for the 40 key events in the New Testament and being shown the props he had used when he had taught the courses previously.

We have become aware of some schools changing their RE Curriculum meaning that there is less Old Testament teaching and more New Testament teaching on the syllabus. We want to be prepared to offer NT Mini to schools and so will be training a number of people to be presenters. Alongside NT Live, Tom Greene will officially train 7 presenters in September. We hope to begin teaching NT Mini in January 2025.

PACE ARE SEEKING A TREASURER

SECONDARY LESSONS

This term we have delivered 23 lessons in 4 different high schools, including Les Varendes for the very first time. We have led sessions on: 'What is Prayer?', 'Jesus: was he mad, bad or God?', 'A Christian Worldview' and 'Faith in the Community'. For the community lesson we took a group of students to Trinity Church to see church life in action, they heard about what the church does to reach its community, explored The Caves and learnt about the work of Guernsey Welfare and heard about what Caring for Ex-offenders do as well. The lesson was well received, and we have another school interested to visit next year!

We are so thankful for the growing number of opportunities to share in secondary schools and grateful to all our volunteers who make these lessons possible.
